The first OYR for fall 2020 will be September 16TH. OYR is for kids in Grades 6 and up on Wednesdays from 3-5pm. Pay close attention to updates because they will be modifying some things to make sure everyone can have fun and stay healthy. Baylynn W. will post updates on the Youth Group Facebook Page.

1. OYR will be taking place completely outdoors as long as the weather allows. This means that if we get a forecast for rain or crazy cold temps in September or October OYR will be cancelled. Baylynn will notify the school and ask us to make an announcement if a last minute cancellation happens.

2. OYR will only go from 3 pm - 5 pm. This means no dinner meal will be served. Since we won't be asking for meal donations it would be great if you could volunteer your time as a chaperone instead!

3. Kids are being asked to bring a mask (incase we have to head indoors), a water bottle, and any snacks they might want.

4. They will evaluate before November if we will be able to safely move OYR indoors for the winter.
