## MARATHON UPDATE!



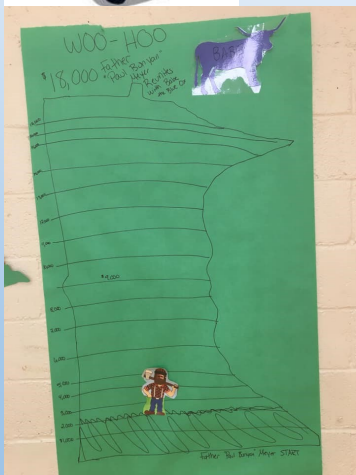

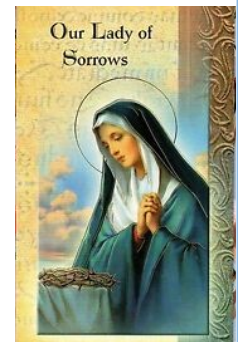
## September is the Month dedicated to Our Lady of Sorrows—Feast Day Sept. 15th
