Last week students had an exciting week for Catholic Schools Week! Dress up days, fun activities, treats and more! Students brought in non-perishable food items and collected 179 pounds of food for the Annandale Food Shelf! We also had a Pennies for Pounds contest, to see which class could bring in the most pennies, which was weighed and tallied by our 4th grade class; this money was also donated to the Annandale Food Shelf.

Students collected 168 pounds of coins, totaling \$316.71! The class that had the heaviest weight for pennies was Preschool, totaling 58.8 pounds! Wow! 
**Prayer to Our Lady of Lourdes, Feast Day Feb. 11th**
