TECHNOLOGY FEES & AGREEMENT

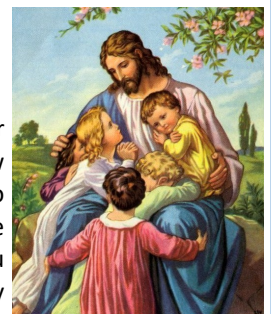
