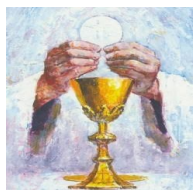
SCHOOL ARRIVAL TIMES

TECHNOLOGY FEES & AGREEMENT

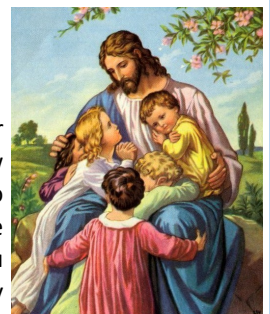

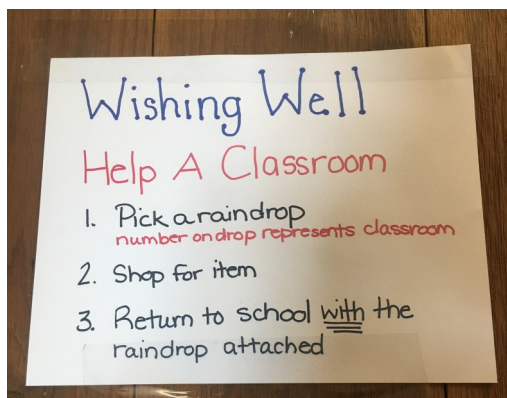
