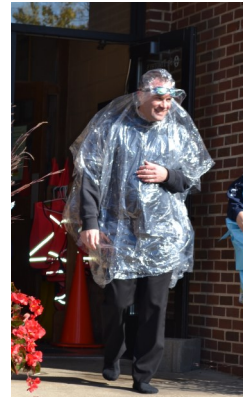

Each box will then be filled by the kids at Open Youth Room who will carefully select each item for a child who they will pray for as they pack the box.
