Our Fall Marathon fundraiser is underway! **Can you help us reach our goal?**

This year we are celebrating The Church of Saint Timothy's 100th birthday with a Birthday Party themed Marathon! To kick off the Marathon fundraising students had a Pep Rally the first week of school, then last week, students played their first Marathon game on Friday! They had fun trying to pop balloons with bean bags!

Each Friday, students gather together to learn how much they have collected in pledges, to pray for the special prayer intentions they have gathered, and to enjoy a fun game or activity!

So far, students have brought in about \$2,300 in pledges! Our goal this year is **\$23,400**, and if each family brings in their goal of \$300 we will reach that goal! We still have a ways to go, and just have a little over 2 weeks to collect pledges, but we know we can do it! Remember to turn in your pledges this Friday by 9am for our weekly count! 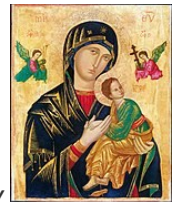
LUNCH STATEMENTS

Prayer to Our Mother of Perpetual Help

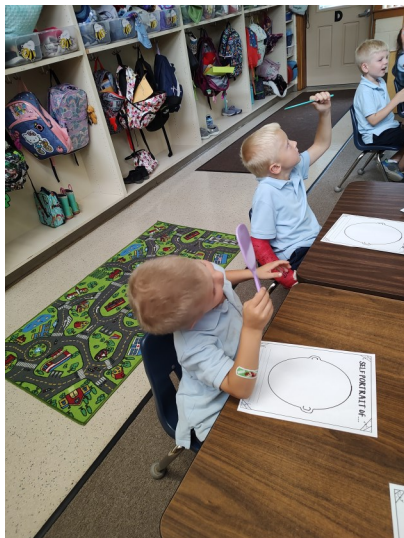
