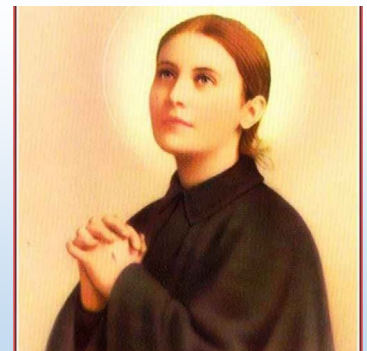
Our Middle School students have been busy in Enrichment Class! 6th grade students had a sewing unit and made some beautiful pillows! Great job students!
