Christ-Like Behavior Presentation

Advent Greetings,

This has been an eventful week for our students. We are busy getting ready for the Christmas Concert on Monday. It is going to be great! We also are looking at our general overall behavior in school and see a need to raise the level of Christ-like behaviors and lower the level of non-Christ-like behaviors. We presented in each classroom on this very topic. We discussed Christ-like Behaviors versus Non-Christ Like Behaviors. As you know, our Christ-like behaviors call students to be caring, honest, respectful, people of integrity, self-controlled, and teachable. Non-Christ-like behaviors fall into categories of being rude, mean, and a bully. We are seeing behaviors of not listening, pushing in lines, disrespect for others including teachers, and name-calling to share a few.

We will be working especially hard to enforce Christ-like behaviors and the consequences of non-Christ like behavior in the school relying on existing policy so that we can have the best learning environment and caring place for all.

We are called to be like Jesus and that is who we are calling our school to be. Thank you talking at home about being Christ-like. Together, we can create change.
