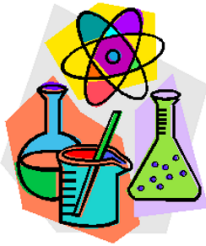

Students in grades PreK-2 can eat breakfast before Mass, but should arrive by 7:45am so there is adequate time to finish breakfast. Students in grades 3-8 can eat breakfast after Mass.

The application period for scholarships through AIM Higher closes next Friday, February 23rd.

AIM Higher offers two scholarships, worth \$1000 each.

1. THE AIM HIGHER SCHOLARSHIP The Aim Higher Scholarship is awarded to students from families seeking tuition assistance. The scholarship follows students through 8th grade and to other Catholic schools.
2. THE CSAF/AIM HIGHER SCHOLARSHIP The CSAF/Aim Higher Scholarship is awarded to five students from families with the most tuition assistance need per eligible school.

The Aim Higher application period is from Nov. 1—Feb. 23.

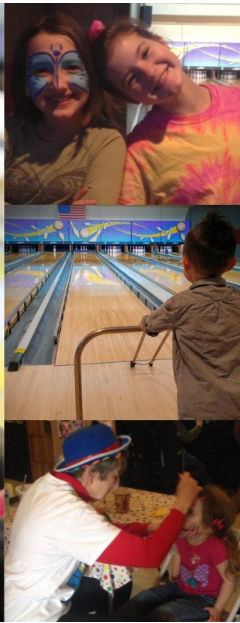
