

#### **DEADLINE IS TOMORROW FEBRUARY 23rd**

The application period for scholarships through AIM Higher closes next Friday, February 23rd.

AIM Higher offers two scholarships, worth \$1000 each.

- 1. THE AIM HIGHER SCHOLARSHIP The Aim Higher Scholarship is awarded to students from families seeking tuition assistance. The scholarship follows students through 8th grade and to other Catholic schools.
- 2. THE CSAF/AIM HIGHER SCHOLARSHIP The CSAF/Aim Higher Scholarship is awarded to five students from families with the most tuition assistance need per eligible

The Aim Higher application period is from Nov. 1—Feb. 23.
