This weekend, March 8th - 10th, Saint Ignatius Catholic Church and The Church of Saint Timothy are coming together in a special forty hours of continuous prayer and adoration. The

Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at the Church of Saint Ignatius from 8:00 pm Friday through 5:00 pm Saturday and at The Church of St Timothy from 6:00 pm Saturday through the closing Mass at 4:00 pm on Sunday. Led prayer is scheduled at various times throughout the forty-hour period, as well as abundant time for quiet and uninterrupted personal prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. The forty hours of devotion closes with Holy Mass at 4:00 pm on Sunday, March 10th at Saint Timothy with Bishop Joseph Williams.
